Designing with Acid Etching

WS-101-A Saturday August 26 (10am-4pm)

WS- 101-B Saturday September 16 (10am-4pm)

Cost per student: 140.00

All materials provided except silver.

Course Objectives: In this workshop students will learn how to properly use acid to etch both silver and copper. We will focus on multiple layered etching which gives the illusion of depth in metal. Learn how to etch designs with free hand drawing as well as transferred images. You will love all of the amazing textures you can achieve with little effort. Students will create an etched ring or necklace during the workshop.

Jewelry In a Day

Kit Available

Course Objectives: Have you ever thought that you'd like to learn about jewelry making but haven't had the time to take a regular class? This workshop will touch on the basics of jewelry making including soldering, cutting with a jewelers saw, flexible drill, stamping, sanding, hydraulic forming and much more. During the day students will make earrings, a necklace, a ring, and a bracelet. You will be amazed at what you can make in here. And no we won't use a hot glue gun. No prior metal experience.

Fantastic Silver Chains

WS-104-A Saturday October14 (10am-4pm)

Cost per Student: 140.00

All materials included except sterling.

Course Objectives: In this class we will explore the many ways a chain can be constructed. A chain doesn't have to be made only of thin wire. We will explore wire wrapping, chain mail, making small forms and connecting them with rings. If you want to learn about ways to create fantastic chain pieces to be worn as necklaces or bracelets, you will love this class. We will practice with copper, and then move to silver. Students will complete several samples and a bracelet using a newly learned technique. Metals background is helpful but not necessary.

Alternative Materials

WS-102-A Saturday November 18 (10am-4pm)

Cost per student: 140.00

All materials are included in price except for sterling silver.

Course Objectives: In this class we will examine many ways of adding color and texture to metal without the use of stones. Processes demonstrated will include epoxy inlay, concrete inlay, plexi carving and forming, and rivets for use with pictures and other heat sensitive materials. Basic soldering techniques will be demonstrated for those with no prior experience. Those who have a metals background will be able to incorporate the inlay processes into their current body of work.

Adorn Your Pet

All materials included.

Course Objectives: In this workshop students will enjoy learning how to make a one of a kind pet tag for their beloved companion. I created a sterling pet tag for my cat the day of his adoption and feel that all pets need to be reminded how special they are to us. Students will be provided materials to create an elaborate pet tag from sterling silver and other materials. You can even incorporate a picture of yourself or your pet in the tag.

****Jewelry Kits are available for any of the listed classes. Kits do not include silver...it is determined by market price and we will order in class. I strongly recommend purchasing a kit unless you are familiar with the materials. Kits are \$30.00**

Early Bird Discounts: Receive \$15 off of 15-week classes, if registered and paid two weeks prior to the start of any class.

Private Lessons: Private lessons are available at \$55.00 per 3-hour block for any skill level.

Open Studio: Open studio time is available at \$15.00 per 3-hour block. Open studio means that the student has full student level studio usage for time paid. NO instruction is given during open studio. Anyone attending an open studio session, working or not, must pay the same fee. Open studio time is offered only to past and present FC Drea students.

All jewelry classes at F. C. Dréa Design are adult classes. Due to the types of materials and tools used in class, students must be 18 years of age or older. Under 18 must enroll with a parent or at my discretion.
